on its administration its taxes its markets its currency its weights and measures and the like his route then continued along the southern coast of arabia into the gulf and he presumably returned home to the east via iraq the author is a wonderful observer of people their buildings their dress their customs their agriculture their food and their history this book is a unique source for the social and economic history of thirteenth century south arabia written with a humour and wit otherwise unknown in the writings of medieval islam the text is of major linguistic importance too written as it is in a far from classical arabic this translation is fully annotated with an introduction appendices glossary and full index and contains maps and illustrations
